South Florida EnergyWhiz Expo 2019-20 RULES SUPPLEMENT To the

STATE Solar Energy Cook-off (SCO) Rules

Eligibility Requirements

- The Yellow Division comprises teams whose most senior member is in the 3rd through 5th grade. Each school may register up to two teams in this division.
- The Orange Division comprises teams whose most senior member is in the 6th through 8th grade. Each school may register up to two teams in this division.
- The Red Division comprises teams whose most senior member is in the 9th through 12th grade. Each school may register up to two teams in this division.

Construction Requirements

- o The use of Fresnel lenses will not be permitted. No exceptions.
- The Cooker Design/Build form (including photo) does not need to be completed. It should not be emailed to penny@fsec.ucf.edu unless participating in the State EnergyWhiz after regionals.

Cooking Requirements

- At least four copies of the recipe (see recipe submission form on website) need to be made available on competition day. One needs to be turned in to administrative staff by 8:30 a.m. and the other three need to be presented to judges. Extra copies may be distributed to the general public.
- o At least three servings must be cooked.
- A separate award will not be given for the best "Fresh From Florida" dish but culinary points will still be awarded for using said produce/products.

Competition Day

- Students may not participate on more than one team in SCO, even if that other team is in another division.
- o Students participating in SCO may not participate in JSS due to potential scheduling conflicts.
- o There will be no judging for the Fresh From Florida Award but culinary points will still be awarded for using said produce/products.
- o Properly leashed service animals who have been officially trained to assist an owner may be allowed entry. Service animals must be with their owner at all times. Proper documentation may be checked upon entry at our discretion or the discretion of Boca Raton Community High School. No other animals will be allowed on-site.

Awards

- o Third place awards for each divisional competition are not guaranteed to be given.
- o The Fresh From Florida Award will not be given.
- o The WOW! Award will not be given.
- o First place overall awards will be given for each division, based on the highest total score for both competitions. This award comes with free registration to the State EnergyWhiz in Cocoa, FL on April 25, 2020.
- o A grand prize award will be given to the one team with the highest total overall score, regardless of division. This award comes with a \$100.00 cash prize.
