DAYS AND HOURS OF OPERATION

The FAU/Pine Jog Spring Camp Program has been created as a partnership between Florida Atlantic University and Pine Jog Elementary School. The Spring Camp program is a program providing a unique experience for your child(ren) on a daily basis.

The Spring Camp Program will run from **Monday, March 23rd, 2020** to **Friday, March 27th, 2020.**

Program Hours: 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

ADMISSION / WITHDRAWAL

Enrollment in our program will be limited to approximately 18 children per group. A waiting list of names will be started once groups are filled. We will contact you as soon as a spot becomes available for your child.

A registration fee of **\$25.00** per child is required at the time of registration for the Spring Camp Program. This fee guarantees a space for your child(ren) in the program.

*** REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE ***

Placement in the Spring Camp Program will be <u>full-time</u>. If for any reason you need to withdraw a child from the FAU/Pine Jog Spring Camp Program, no refunds will be given. **Absence from Spring Camp does not waive fees**.

CONTINUED ENROLLMENT IN OUR PROGRAM IS DEPENDENT UPON <u>TIMELY</u> PAYMENT OF FEES.

IF YOU HAVE NOT PAID BY MARCH 3, 2020, YOUR CHILD WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ATTEND THE PROGRAM.

Each child in our program has a reserved place whether or not the child is present. No payment adjustments or refunds will be made for absences, vacations, or withdrawals from the Spring Camp Program.

ABSENCES

If your child (ren) will be absent please contact the Spring Camp office at **561-656-5430**. Due to the comprehensive nature of the program schedule, your child(ren) will be immersed in an array of activities and we encourage your child(ren) to participate fully. We request that early pick-up of your child(ren) be kept to a minimum.

PINE JOG SPRING CAMP ACTIVITIES

Students in the Pine Jog Spring Camp Program will be placed in groups according to grade levels. There is one Counselor per group. Please do not allow your child to bring toys, and electronics to the Spring Camp Program.

In addition, your child(ren) will be immersed in a variety of enrichment activities on a daily basis. The activities will include both inside and outside activities and field trip activities will vary on a daily basis. A schedule of activities will be provided to you at the beginning of the week of camp, as well as posted in our website: www.pinejog.fau.edu

Some of our enrichment activities which may include but are not limited to: Environmental Education (by Pine Jog Environmental Education Center); Variety of Sports; Arts & Crafts, Music, Dance, Gardening, Reading, Field Trip, etc. and will vary on a daily basis.

STUDENT PICK UP

Only authorized adults that have been indicated on your child (ren)'s registration form may pick-up and leave with your child(ren) from the Spring Camp Program.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR REGISTRATION FORM UPDATED AT ALL TIMES!

When arriving to the pick-up area, the authorized individual must indicate the time of pick-up, print and sign their name on the authorized sign-out form and must sign in blue or black ink only. No child will be released to anyone who is not on file or not authorized in writing by the custodial parent. A picture ID is required at time of pick-up by each individual, including the

child's parent. Anyone under 18 years of age picking up a child from the program must have a notarized letter by the custodial parent authorizing pickup. You will pick your child (ren) up at the designated pick-up location each day. No one is permitted to enter the school and pick-up their child from a classroom. Your child(ren) will be escorted safely from the program to the designated pick-up area. No one is permitted to enter the school beyond the pick-up area without the permission of the Spring Camp Director. All of these policies are in place to safeguard your child(ren) and all staff on the premises of the school. We appreciate your cooperation in following this very important procedure.

We appreciate your patience while waiting for your child.

LATE PICK UP/ABANDONED CHILDREN POLICY

Please call the Pine Jog Spring Camp Office at 561-656-5430 if you will be late picking up your child (ren). A **\$10.00** late fee will be charged to those parents whose child(ren) is not picked up by 5:30 p.m. For each additional 10 minutes, there is an additional **\$10.00** fee.

ALL LATE FEES ARE TO BE PAID AT THE TIME OF PICK UP.

Chronically late pick-ups could lead to your child(ren) being withdrawn from the Program.

If you have not contacted the Program by 5:30 p.m., the Program will contact the Department of Children and Families and the Palm Beach County Sherriff's Department. The child(ren) will be removed from the Program.

INJURY AND ILLNESS

The FAU/Pine Jog Spring Camp Program strives to provide a safe program for your child(ren); however, injury or illness may occur. All Spring Camp staff have been trained and certified in first aid and CPR. In the event of an injury or illness the Spring Camp Program will notify you either by phone or by incident/accident report based upon the injury or illness. It is imperative that you keep all emergency phone numbers and addresses up-to-date with the Program.

IMMUNIZATIONS

Your child's immunization record must be submitted at the time of registration. A copy of the exemption from Immunizations for Reason of Conscience must be submitted along with the Spring Camp registration forms.

STUDENT CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

In order to provide a fun-learning environment for each child in the Spring Camp Program, a code of conduct has been implemented. Please make sure that you take a few minutes to go over this code of conduct with your child(ren).

Consequences for misbehavior or failure to adhere to FAU/Pine Jog Spring Camp Program Code of Conduct will be as follows:

First Referral 30 minutes removal from group

Second Referral 45 minutes removal from group

Third Referral Removal from the group for the remainder of

the day AND Parent's conference if needed.

Fourth Referral SUSPENSION from Spring Camp Program

MEDICATIONS

Under Florida law, Camp may only give medication that is prescribed by a physician with an authorized form signed by the physician and the parent. Medication must be in its original container with the pharmacy label and the student's name, medication name, current dose and frequency.
